a + consonant	<u>b</u> anana, <u>b</u> iscuit, <u>s</u> andwich
an + vowel (a, e, i, o, u)	<u>a</u> rm, <u>e</u> gg, <u>o</u> range

Use *a* or *an* with one thing: **a** banana, **a** sandwich, **an** egg, **an** orange.
Don't use *a/an* with these words: *cheese, rice, soup, tea, water, milk, juice.*
